**Why do we graft Noble fir?**

Grafting is a BIG part of the operation here at Bear Canyon Tree Farm. Most of the trees we sell that are over 9 feet tall are grafted.

We graft for our big trees in order to obtain those beautiful full vibrant trees that have smaller trunks and great foliage. With this process we get complete control over the look of the new tree. A grafted tree has mature foliage that looks fresher and healthier and keeps better than an immature or juvenile tree that is grown from seed.
