Where do grafts come from?

Photo is overlooking a field of 12' to 15' grafted Noble fir.

We select our cuttings from older (specimen) trees. Many of these were grafted years ago. These are trees that have qualities we know will produce gorgeous trees on the graft. Some of our favorite specimen trees have been handed down for three generations. Whenever we find a gorgeous tree in a new field that has all of the characteristics needed for grafting, we take cuttings from it. These cuttings are then grafted onto seedlings, thus preserving all of those outstanding qualities. Each tree that we keep is a “one-in-a-million” specimen tree.
